

PTQ Procedure Update



Help Desk Quarter 1 (Oct-Dec) Support Summary




Case Resolution Statistics

Old Business – My SPARK Learning Lab Recommendations

RAC members suggested that the glossary included in the I-SAT Guide be posted elsewhere in My SPARK Learning Lab to improve accessibility.

A glossary has been added to My SPARK Learning Lab that provides key terms and acronyms used by SPARK and the ECE system RAC members asked SPARK to add clarifying language to the question in the My Profile section that asks users about their interest in joining the "rating system".

Two questions on the My Profile page of My SPARK Learning Lab have been updated based on feedback: Question referencing "Rating system" has been updated to "PTQ" and another referencing "Self Assessment" has been updated to "I-SAT"

CPR Renewal

CPR and First Aid requirements are necessary per Indiana Code (IAC 3-1.1-32), stating that certification of current first aid training and annual CPR certification required for direct child care providers. This code also states that CPR certification is valid for one year regardless of the expiration date listed on the card.




